


Guidelines for JLPT July 2025.

1. Applicants are requested to bring medium-soft Black Pencils (either No. 2 or HB), Eraser, the test voucher, and his/her photo ID on the day of the test. **Please do not use Ball Pen or Ink Pen for writing answers / your name / examination number on Answer sheets.**

2. **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**

MOBILE PHONES, SMART WATCHES, AND ANY ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE THE EXAMINATION CENTER.

 **If found carrying any prohibited item during the exam, strict action will be taken which may lead to cancellation of your exam.**

3. Examinees who will commit misconduct** will have test results invalidated for all test sections and will not receive a certificate of result and scores from the Japan Foundation.

*Starting Time for N1 and N2 exam: 9.00 am

* Starting Time for N3, N4, N5 exam: 1.00 pm
(Reporting Time 12.15pm)

**** Misconduct means any one of the following acts.**

- a. If any candidate is found carrying a mobile phone or any electronic device inside the examination center, it will be treated as misconduct on the spot, and strict disciplinary action will be taken as per the examination rules.
- b. Candidates who fail to produce valid identity proof at the examination center will be treated as misconduct, and appropriate action will be taken as per the

examination rules. It is mandatory for all candidates to carry and present their original identity proof at the time of entry.

- c.** An examinee who provides others with answers, or who obtains answers from other examinees, or who uses a dictionary, textbook, reference book, crib sheet, mobile phone, or who writes answers in advance on his or her desk or writing equipment;
- d.** An examinee who is found to be taking the test for someone else, or to have asked someone to take the test on his or her behalf, or an examinee whose identity could not be verified due to the use of a fraudulent ID or other such reason;
- e.** An examinee who fails to follow the proctor's instructions;
- f.** An examinee who takes the question booklets and/or answer sheets outside the test room with him/her, takes photos of the question booklets and/or answer sheets, or takes the contents of the question booklets and/or answer sheets outside the test room by copying them or recording them;
- g.** An examinee who disturbs other examinees in any way;
- h.** An examinee who shares the test contents and answers, photos of the question booklets and/or answer sheets, or audio content of the listening test via the Internet or any other means of communication with any third party, and vice versa;
- i.** An examinee who cooperates with someone committing misconduct (b), (c), (e), (f), (g) or (h).
