

NOTICE FOR LATE ARRIVALS

a Previously, arriving up to 10 minutes late was allowed for each section.

From the July 2026 test, late arrival is not allowed for any section.

If an examinee does not arrive by the **Check-in Time**, the examinee will be marked absent for the first section.

For the second and later sections, examinee who arrive after the test start time are **not allowed** to enter the test room or take the test.

IMPORTANT



Please arrive at the test center on time.
Late arrival is not allowed for any section.

b As before, examinees may start the test from the second or third section.

However, if an examinee does not take all sections, **the examinee will fail the test.**

IMPORTANT



- You must take **ALL** sections of the test.
- If you skip any section and do not complete the test, your result will be invalidated.
- Plan your schedule carefully to complete every section.

MISCONDUCT

If you commit or attempt to commit any of the misconducts listed below, your test results for all sections will be invalidated. Proctors will report the misconduct to the local test head office. You will be notified that your test results will be invalidated. Please follow all instructions from the proctors at all times.

2		<p>Cheating Providing or obtaining answers, or using a dictionary, textbook, reference book, crib sheet, earphone, mobile phone or any other devices with camera and communicating functions, or writing answers in advance on your desk or writing equipment.</p>
3		<p>Taking the test for someone else, asking someone to take the test on your behalf, or using a fraudulent ID or other reason that makes your identity unverifiable.</p>
4		<p>Failing to follow the proctor's instructions.</p>
5		<p>Taking the question booklets and/or answer sheets outside the test room, taking photos of them, or copying or recording their contents in any way.</p>
6		<p>Disturbing other examinees in any way.</p>
7		<p>Cooperating with someone committing misconduct (2)–(6).</p>

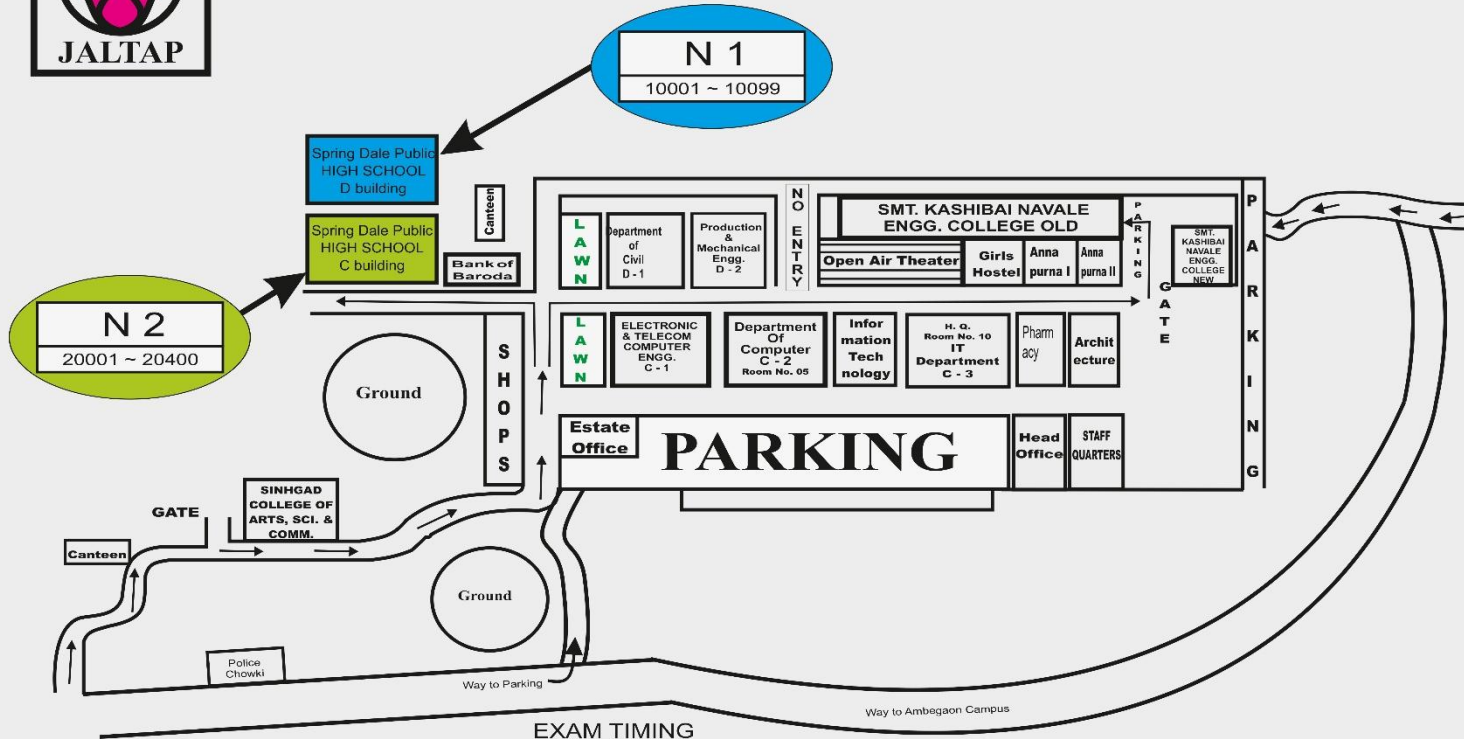
